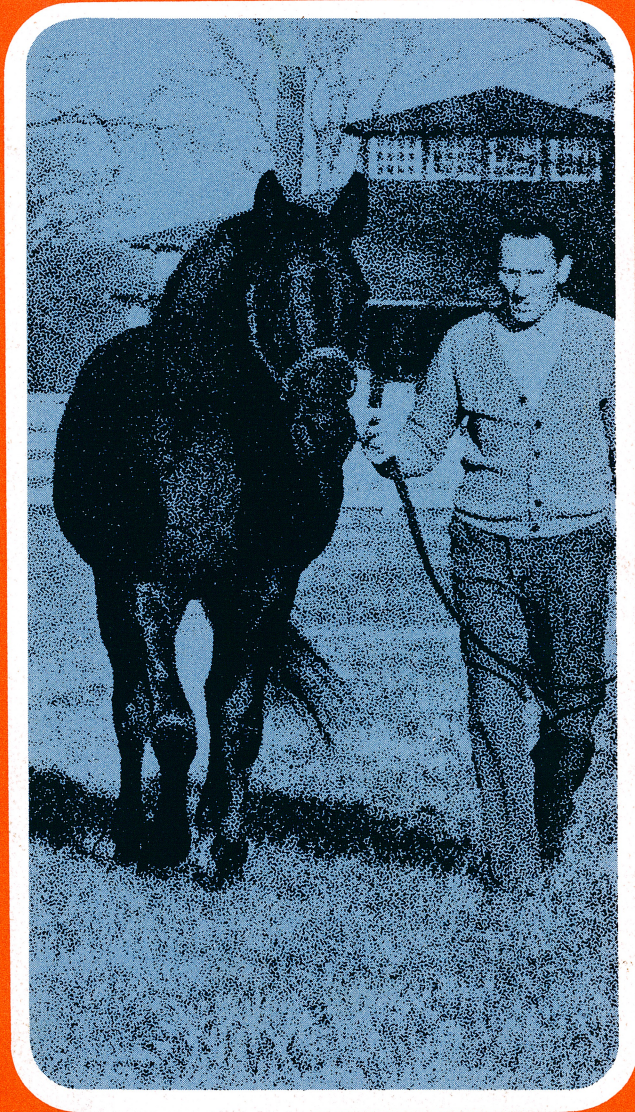

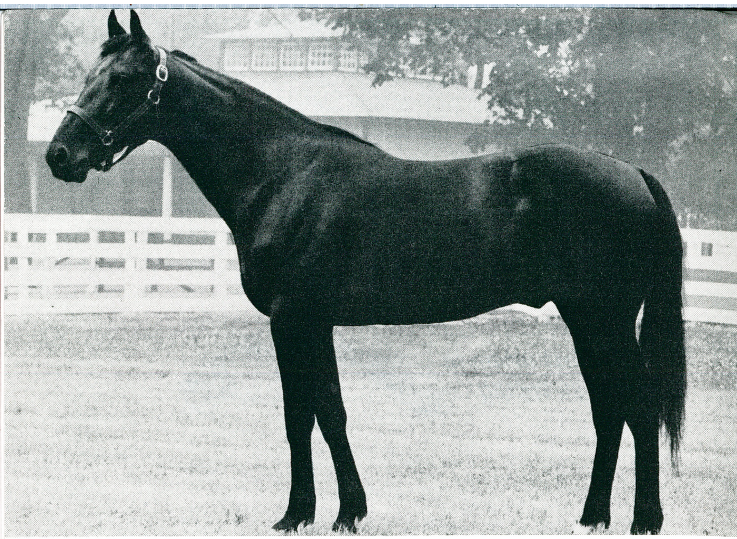

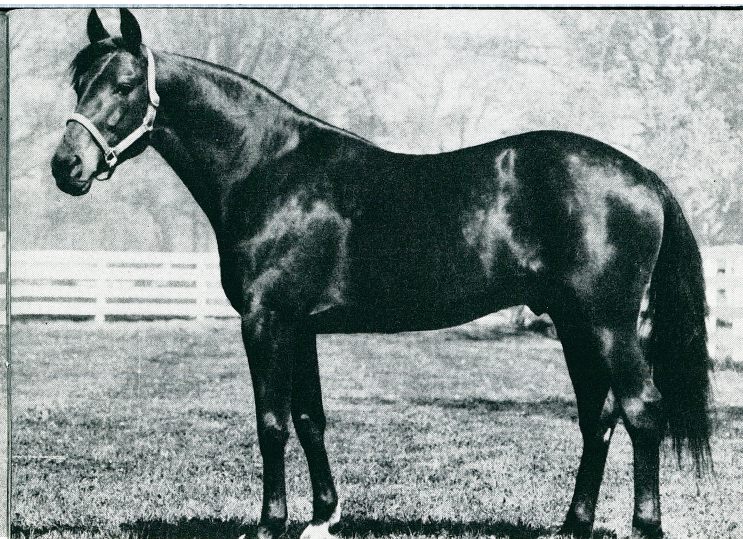
ALBATROSS was an outstanding World Champion at 2, winning 14 of 17 heats and earning \$183,540, the most money ever won by a two-year-old. In the process he established four new Track Records.

At three, ALBATROSS set five different World Records including the fastest race mile ever (1:54 3/5f), the fastest two heats ever (1:54 3/5f-1:54 3/5f) and the most money ever earned by a Standardbred in a single season—\$558,009. He was chosen "Harness Horse Of The Year" in 1971.

At four, ALBATROSS paced the fastest racing mile in history in winning at Sportsman's Park in 1:54 3/5f. During his career of only three seasons ALBATROSS paced thirty-seven 2:00 miles, set seven World and nine Track Records and retired with earnings of \$1,201,470.

ALBATROSS' first foals will arrive in the fall of 1973.

AYRES was an outstanding World Champion at both two and three. At two, he established a World Record for two-year-olds on a half-mile track regardless of sex or gait. This also equalled the then existing all age record for trotting stallions on a half-mile track. At three, he won the "Triple Crown" including the Hambletonian, Kentucky Futurity and Yonkers Futurity. He also equalled the World Record (1:56 4/5) for three-year-old trotters and established a new two heat record for three-year-old trotters in winning the Hambletonian.

Superbly bred, AYRES is by the greatest of all trotting sires Star's Pride T1:57 1/5 and out of the Hoot Mon 3,2:00 mare Arpege, she a sister to the Kentucky Futurity winner Cassin Hanover 3,2:02 1/5, the dam of the International champion Elma 3,T1:58 4/5.

From his first few crops AYRES has produced numerous Stakes Winners including the 1970 Hambletonian, Kentucky Futurity and Colonial winner Timothy T. 3,1:58 4/5.

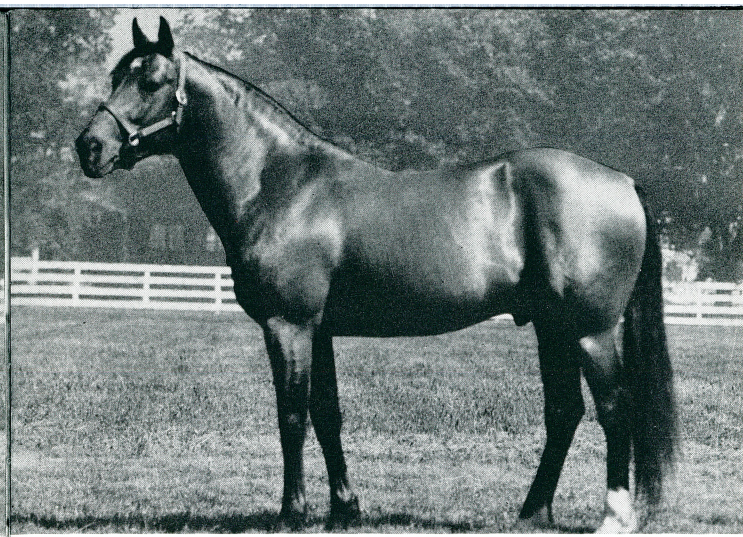
FIRST FOALS ARE THREE YEAR OLDS IN 1973

BEST OF ALL was an outstanding World Champion at two, three and four. At two, he won seven miles in 2:00 or better, the most ever by a two-year-old, and was voted "Two-Year-Old Pacer of 1966." He won seven major Stakes events at 2 including the historic Fox Stake. At three, he won nine two-minute race miles including the classic Little Brown Jug. At four, he won ten more miles in 2:00 or better and was voted "Four-Year-Old Pacer of 1968." BEST OF ALL retired at four with lifetime earnings of \$548,899 and twenty-six 2:00 race miles.

BEST OF ALL is a full brother to the great Stakes Winner and former World Champion Coffee Break p,2,1:58 ½, 3,1:57 and to the Stakes Winning filly and 2:00 producer Lady Jewell p,2,T2:01 ¾, 3,T1:59. He is by the illustrious 2:00 sire Good Time and out of the Knight Dream mare Besta Hanover, she a half sister to three different 2:00 producing broodmares.

From his first crop BEST OF ALL was the leading percentage sire of 2:10 two-year-olds in 1972. His second crop (two-year-olds of 1973) includes the Season's Champions and multiple Stakes Winners Boyden Hanover, DeBuena Fuente, Bestman Hanover, All Laura, Bonny Brook Best, Judy Hanover and numerous other fast freshmen pacers.

BULLET HANOVER retired at three, having established six different World Records in just two years of racing. His numerous Stakes wins included the classic Fox Stake and the Little Brown Jug.

An instant success in the stud BULLET HANOVER became the first 2:00 two-year-old to sire a 2:00 two-year-old and he accomplished this from his first crop. His numerous outstanding performers include many top fillies as well as colts. Among his 2:00 stars are such outstanding pacers as Tuxedo Hanover p,3,T1:58 ¾, Ember Hanover p,3,T1:59 ¾, Nemma Hanover p,3,1:59 ¾, Valley Sampson p,1:58 ¾f, Josiah p,1:58 ¾f, and the Free-For-All Winner Carbine Hanover p,3,2:00 ½h, 1:59 ½f-1:59 ¾h.

One of the first fillies by BULLET HANOVER to enter the broodmare ranks Bewitch Hanover p,2,1:59 ¾ is from her first foal the dam of the extremely fast Bogart Hanover p,3,1:59 ¾h, 4,1:58 and the 1973 Season's Champion Bestman Hanover p,2,2:01 ¾f-2:02h. It appears that BULLET HANOVER is headed toward the same success as a broodmare sire that he has enjoyed as a sire.

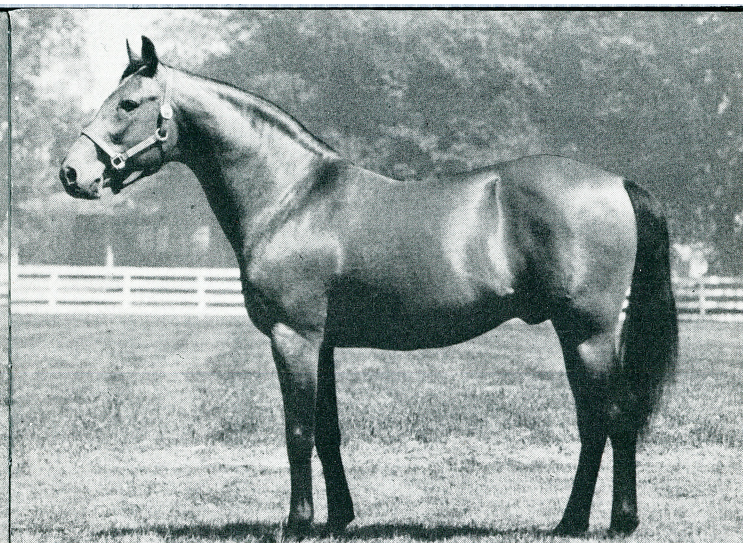
FIRST FOALS ARE YEARLINGS IN 1973

COLUMBIA GEORGE is the fastest son of his illustrious sire Good Time. He set three different World Records at 2 and 3 including: the fastest mile ever on a half-mile track by a two-year-old (1:58¾), the all age World Record for two heats (1:56-1:56) and the most 2:00 wins in one season by a Standard-bred (15). He retired with lifetime earnings of \$398,274 from only two seasons of racing. A Season's Champion at both two and three, COLUMBIA GEORGE won 19 different Stakes and Futurity events valued at over \$15,000, and in the process set many track and regional records.

COLUMBIA GEORGE brings to the stud a pedigree open to the top broodmare bloodlines available. His dam Mitzi Eden is a Stakes Winning daughter of the multiple 2:00 producing Billy Direct matron Tallulah Hanover. Tallulah Hanover's progeny includes the outstanding Stakes Winner Rivaltime p,2,2:01½h, 3,1:58-1:58¾h, in addition to three other Stakes Winners, two 2:00 sires, and two 2:00 producing daughters.

COLUMBIA GEORGE's first foals are yearlings in 1973.

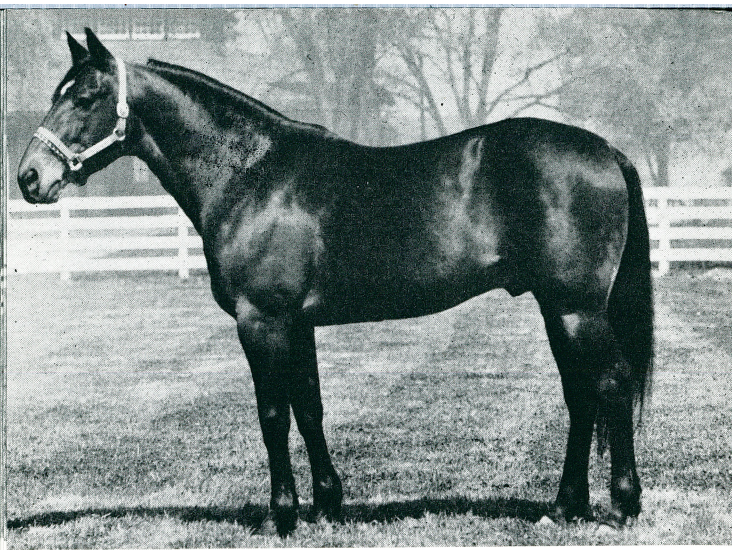

DANCER HANOVER has firmly established himself as one of the world's leading speed sires. He now ranks first as the leading living 2:00 sire by the great Adios.

DANCER HANOVER's numerous outstanding performers include the World Champion brothers Romeo Hanover p,2,1:59, 3,1:56¼f and Romulus Hanover p,2,2:00¼f-2:00¾h, 3,1:57¼f-1:58¾h and such extremely fast pacers as Seton Hanover p,2,1:59, Romalie Hanover p,2,1:58, 3,1:57¾f, Betty Hanover p,3,T1:57¾, Waltzing Home p,1:59¼f, Sweetsie p,3,T1:59, etc. DANCER HANOVER is considered a great sire of fillies and mares as well as colts and horses. DANCER HANOVER has already sired the winners of in excess of \$6,000,000 and twenty-three 2:00 pacers.

One of the first fillies by DANCER HANOVER to enter the broodmare ranks, Voodoo Hanover is from her first foal the dam of the fastest racehorse in history Albatross p,2,1:57¾, 3,1:54¾, 4,1:54¾f. It appears that DANCER HANOVER is directed towards the same success as a broodmare sire that he has enjoyed as a sire.

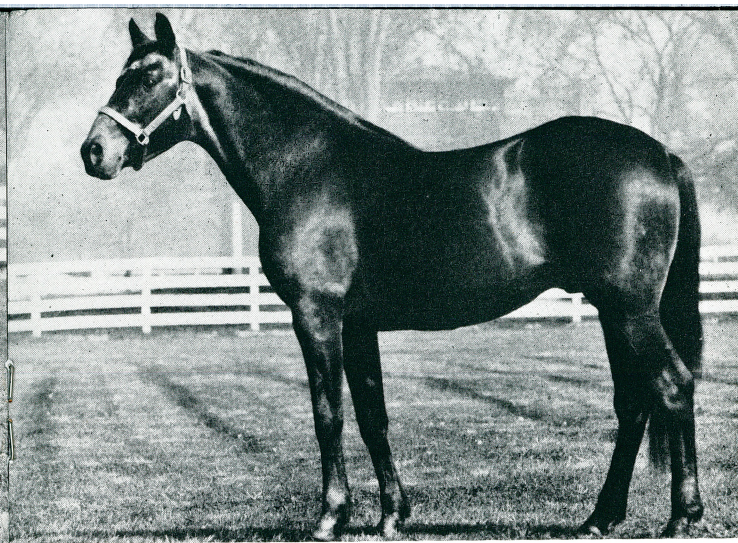

HICKORY SMOKE was an outstanding Stakes Winning two and three-year-olds, his many Stakes wins include the classic Hambletonian Stake. By the World Champion Titan Hanover and out of the Dean Hanover mare Misty Hanover (also the dam of the multiple 2:00 sire Hickory Pride) HICKORY SMOKE is considered the leading exponent of the Axworthy line and his blood is considered to be the perfect complement to the Peter The Great bloodlines carried in mares by Star's Pride, Hoot Mon, Speedster, Rodney, etc.

Already a successful 2:00 trotting sire HICKORY SMOKE is constantly found at or near the top of the list of leading sires and leading percentage sires of two and three-year-old trotters as well as aged performers. His many great trotting stars include the Champions Dayan 2,2:03 1/5f, 3,2:00 1/5f, 4,T1:55 1/5, 2:00 1/2h and the International Winner Elma 2,T2:01 1/5, 3, T1:58 1/5.

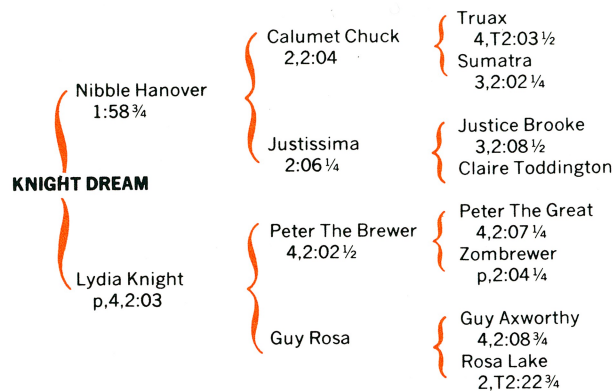

KNIGHT DREAM is the sire of fourteen in 2:00 including such great Champions as Torpid p,2,1:58, 3,1:58-2:00h, Duane Hanover p,4,1:58, Adora's Dream p,1:58 1/2-2:00h, Stormy Dream p,1:58 1/2, etc. For three of the last five years KNIGHT DREAM has been the leading living money winning broodmare sire and it is in this area that his daughters have excelled. KNIGHT DREAM mares have produced twenty-eight 2:00 pacers including such greats as Rum Customer p,2,1:59 1/2, 3,1:56, Best Of All p,2,1:57 1/2, 3,1:57, 4,1:56 1/2, Kat Byrd p,3,1:58 1/2h, Honest Story p,3,T1:55 1/2, etc.

KNIGHT DREAM was a World Champion at both two and three, setting two new World marks at 2, and another one at three. He also established a new World Record for earnings for a two and three-year-old pacer. His numerous Stakes wins include the classic Little Brown Jug.

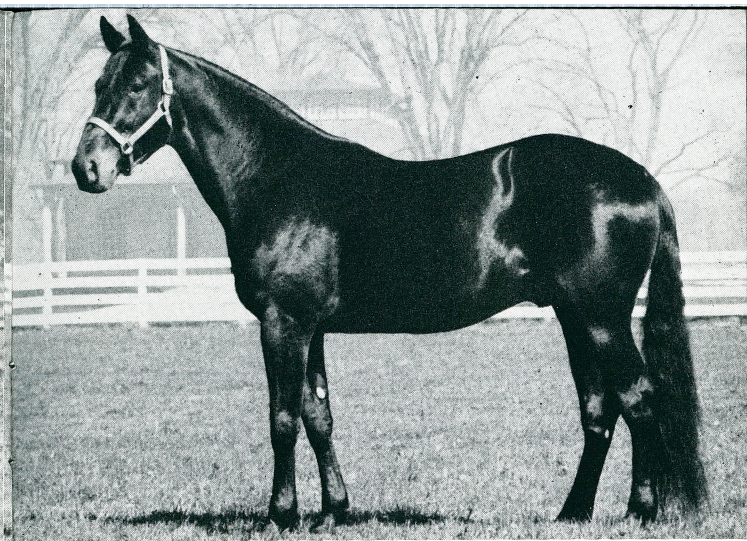

LEHIGH HANOVER was a multiple Stakes Winner at 2, 3 and 4, each year that he raced. At two he won six major stakes taking his record in winning the Meadow Lands Stake in 1:59½ and back in 1:59½. At three, he was voted "Three-Year-Old Pacer of the Year" taking his record in the classic Little Brown Jug.

By the greatest of all sires Adios, and out of the Dean Hanover mare Lucine Hanover, LEHIGH HANOVER is a brother or half brother to five different Stakes Winners and the dam of the Little Brown Jug winner and World Champion Laverne Hanover p,2,1:59½-1:59½h, 3,1:56¾f. LEHIGH HANOVER is already the sire of such fast performers as Going Thru p,1:58¾-1:58¾h, Fashion Chief p,1:59, Scrooge p,3,1:59½h, Lehigh Local p,3,1:59¾f, Perley Hanover p,3,1:59¾, Tate Hanover p,1:59½, Noble Land p,1:59¾, Lehigh Boy p,2,2:00, Lehi Rainbow p,4,2:00½h, etc.

In 1972 LEHIGH HANOVER was the eighth leading money producing sire in North America, his get earning \$1,273,562.

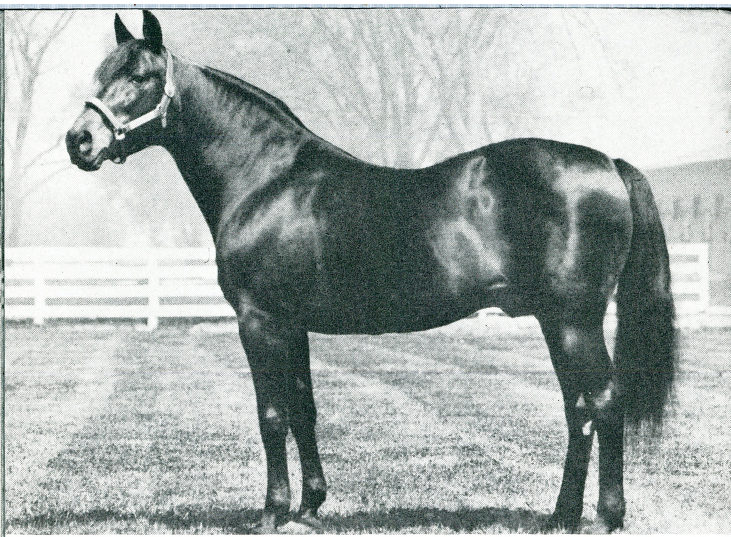

SPEEDY COUNT was a Stakes Winner from two through five, each year that he raced. At two, he twice lowered the World Record for two heats by a two-year-old trotting colt winning in 2:01% and 2:01%, and then back in 2:00% and 2:00%. He won eight major Stakes at two and twelve events at three. By the highly successful trotting sire Speedster and out of the Victory Song mare Countess Song, SPEEDY COUNT is a three quarter brother to the Stakes and Invitational Winner Count Rodney t,2:02¾f, p,2:00¾f. From his first three crops SPEEDY COUNT ranked as one of the leading sires and leading percentage sires of two-year-old trotters in 1970, 1971 and 1972. In 1971 he was the leading percentage sire of two-year-old trotting winners including five different Stakes Winners.

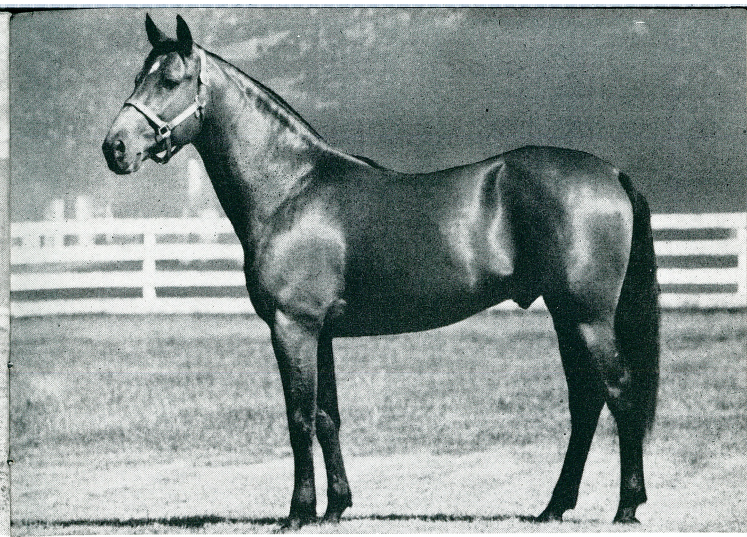

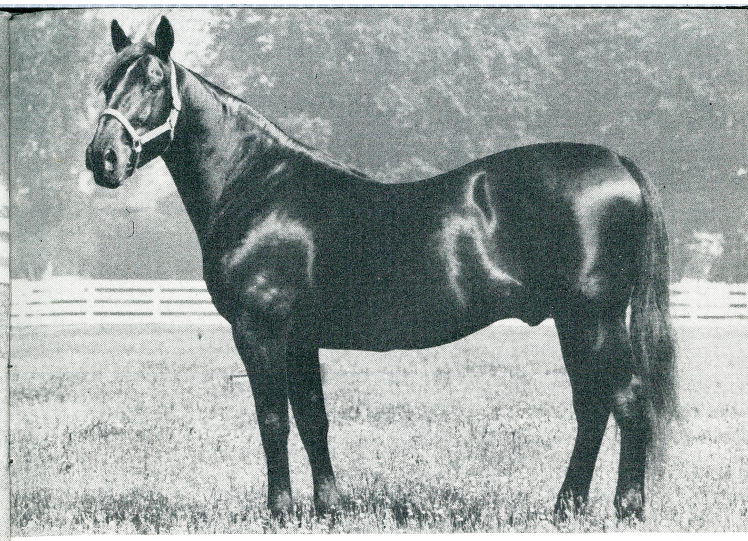
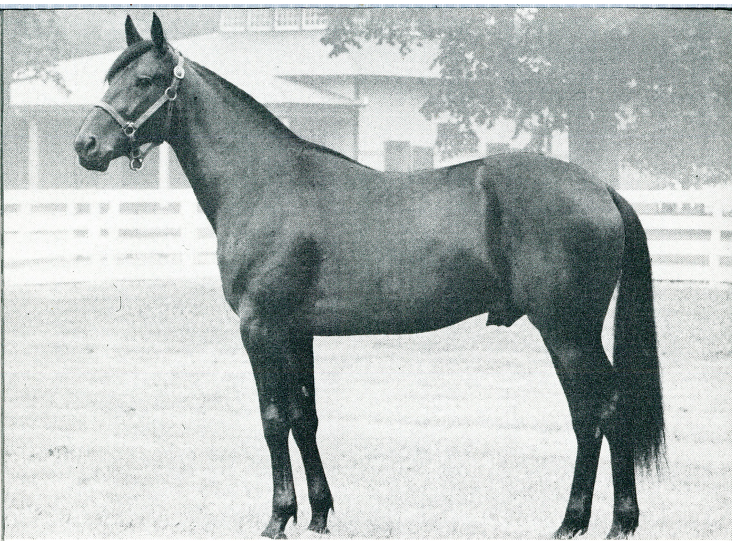

A World Champion at both two and three SUPER BOWL brings to the stud a racing and earnings record unmatched by any young trotter in the history of Harness Racing. At 2, SUPER BOWL earned \$163,898, established a World Record for trotters on a 5/8ths mile track (2:01¹/₂) and was chosen "Two Year-Old Trotter of 1971." At 3, SUPER BOWL established three more World Records, six Track Records, earned \$436,258 and captured the "Triple Crown" including the Hambletonian, the Yonkers Futurity and the Kentucky Futurity.
